Tuesday:

In groups, read the passages and answer multiple choice questions 1-44. You have the entire period to complete this. Note: skip any questions and return to them at the end of the period. Be sure to answer ALL questions (1-44) by the end of the period.

Wednesday

- In groups, for 15 min., read the remaining passage and answer the last set of questions of test packet (45-54).
- The substitute will give the correct answers to ALL of the multiple choice questions. Mark the correct answer on your test.
- Choose any 8 questions that you got incorrect. Use the form on the website and for each question, identify the thinking behind their incorrect answer, and explain why the correct answer is a better choice. Submit to Turnitin.com when completed. In the event that you got less than 8 incorrect, choose any remaining questions explain why it is the BEST choice among the other multiple choice answers.

For example:

Question #	Why was my choice incorrect?	Why is the correct answer is a better choice
23	Because I wasn't sure what the word "Heedless" meant and I knew the tone seemed negative, I chose B (scandalized).	The correct answer "critical" is clearly a better choice since it more accurate reflects a tone that is judgemental and illustrates the parents' frustrations.

Thursday:
