Directions:

Develop a one-page poster with the following:

Have a partner peer-review your writing before making your poster.

- A picture representing your analysis (Pollan's focus) at the top (before the text).
- Under the picture:
 - Pollan's warning to Obama (be sure to include full name and title) - (writing from 3/13/17)
 - Pollan's use of rhetoric (writing from 3/14/17)
 - Analyze whether Pollan would *defend, challenge, or qualify* the claim that **Americans are victims of the food industry** (provide [embedded] evidence in your response) -- remember to use the embedded sentence "form" to help you polish your writing.

Everyone must create a poster and be prepared to present it (without reading it) - on Friday.

If you really can't figure out those programs, then make your poster on a Google Doc.*
